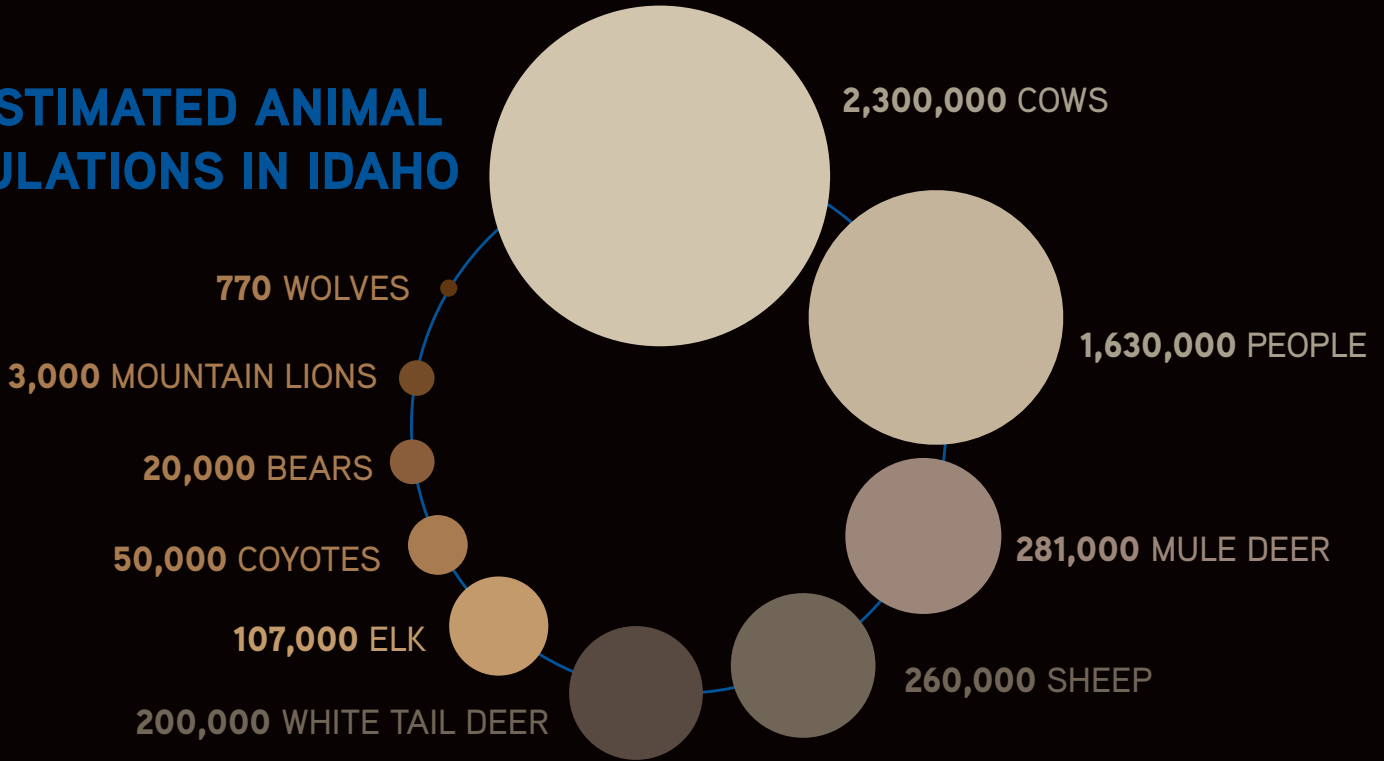


# WOLVES IN IDAHO



## ESTIMATED ANIMAL POPULATIONS IN IDAHO



**770** wolves in Idaho in 2014

**99%** of documented wolf deaths in 2014 were human-caused

Number of gray wolf tags hunters can purchase per calendar year: **5**

From 2009, when Idaho took over management of its wolves, through 2014, people have killed at least **1,970** wolves in Idaho.

**342** wolves killed by humans in 2014

Number of gray wolf tags trappers can buy per trapping season: **5**

## IDAHO LIVESTOCK INFORMATION:

In 2014 wolves killed **43** cows } 1 out of every 52,093 cows  
and **100** sheep } 1 out of every 2,500 sheep



## WHAT IS THE WOLF CONTROL BOARD?

In 2014, Idaho's Governor Butch Otter signed a bill to create a Wolf Control Board designed for the sole purpose of killing Idaho's wolves.

The wolf control board is funded annually with \$400,000 from the state's general tax fund and is supplemented by \$110,000 from Idaho Fish and Game and \$110,000 from Idaho Department of Agriculture.

None of this funding is used for proven effective, non-lethal, livestock conflict prevention techniques. And these funds are also used to kill wolves that are eating elk, their native prey species.
